

68W - EMS Continuing Education

Frequently Asked Questions

WHO SHOULD PARTICIPATE?

All 68Ws* who need sustainment training or Continuing Education Hours for recertification.

WHAT COURSES ARE AVAILABLE?

Health.edu EMS courses and the NREMT categories they fulfill are shown on the [68W Course List](#) available on army.swankhealth.com. Only the courses shown on this list have been reviewed and approved by the Army EMS Programs Management Office. While you may complete any available Health.edu EMS course, **MODS credit will be delayed for courses not listed on the 68W Course List until categories are approved.**

HOW DO I REPORT MY COURSES TO MODS?

EMS courses completed on SwankHealth.com are regularly synchronized to the Army Medical Operational Data System (MODS). Refer to the [MODS Requirements flyer](#) on army.swankhealth.com for details.

ARE THE COURSES ACCREDITED?

Yes. The EMS courses on SwankHealth.com are approved by the Commission on Accreditation for Pre-Hospital Continuing Education (CAPCE). Your CE certificate will display the CAPCE approval number.

HOW MUCH DO THE COURSES COST?

These courses are offered *at no charge* to active duty Army personnel.

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

You must have a SwankHealth.com account to access the online courses. For *immediate registration*, contact your 68W Coordinator.

HOW DO I TAKE A COURSE?

After you log in, go to the Course List tab. Under Health.edu CE/CME section, click the EMS link and choose from the list of course titles. After viewing the course, click the Test link to complete the test and course evaluation. *Please be aware that the entire video must be viewed before you are able to take the test.* After you pass the test (with a score of at least 80%), you may download your certificate. Certificates will remain available on your "My Completed Courses" page.

*68W pertains only to the Army MOS, not Civilian EMS.
